Encounter MIPS Year 3 Epidemic

2019 is the third year of the Quality Payment Program (QPP). For clinicians who participate in the Merit Based Incentive Payment System (MIPS), you will need to earn at least 30 final points to avoid a 7% negative payment adjustment on your Part B Medicare claims in 2021.

- How to create a MIPS reporting plan to tackle important population health issues in Idaho, such as the opioid crisis.
- The new types of clinicians that are included in the program in 2019, as well as other changes.
- Advantages for Clinicians in Small, Rural and underserved areas.
- Identify the final score thresholds for penalty avoidance and exceptional performance.
